## Directions of use



Shake the can vigorously for 2 minutes (with the ball rattling) prior to use.

Spray All-White® in an upwards direction to restore the ceiling tile. Ensure that the spray only comes into contact with the surfaces you want to restore. All-White® should be dry within 30 minutes of use.

**NOTE:** To ensure that the nozzle remains clear after using All-White®, point the can downwards over a disposable surface. Then, spray until only propellant is expelled.

**Caution:** Pressurised container. Protect from sunlight and do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50°C. Do not pierce or burn even after use. Do not spray onto a naked flame or any incandescent material. Contains isodecylopropylamine acetate. May produce an allergic reaction.
